

All abstracts will be desk reviewed and author(s) contacted within one week on the outcome of the review either the abstract is desk rejected with reasons or it is accepted with modifications or it is accepted without modifications. The acceptance of abstract closes May 9, 2019.

FULL PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

ull papers of not more than 6000 words excluding references for oral presentation should be submitted along with plagiarism test result latest September 11, 2019. The APA referencing is strictly advised and colored figures should be accompanied with a corresponding black-n-white version. Accepted papers will be published in conference proceedings, and selected papers with appreciable quality will be considered for publication in a special edition of a Thomson Reuters indexed (open access) journal.
