THEME: DECOLONIZING THE MUSICAL ARTS IN NIGERIA

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

Rationale

Centuries past saw in Africa, Nigeria inclusive, a brain damage; a systematic colonization of a people's psyche, worldview and artistic ingenuity. In the musical domain, the vestiges of colonization could be seen higher and thither in the perception of musical history, in its pedagogy, musical compositions, musical performances, musical aesthetics, musical technology, religious music, to mention but a few. This 5th biennial national conference promises to brainstorm around the polemics of colonization in the musical arts, critiquing the concept itself, exploring variant dimensions of this controversial experience as it concerns musicologists and hazarding possible solutions to the problem since "it is better", some people say, "to light a candle than to keep cursing the darkness".
