LANGUAGE- English

TITLE- to be as brief as possible and typed in sentence case i.e all letters in lower case except the first letter of the first word of the title. Abstract tittle word limit is **25 words**.

AUTHORS- Each author's surname should be in full and other names indicated by initials. Corresponding Authors should provide phone number and email address and the presenting author should be underlined.

ABSTRACT- Abstract body word limit is **250 words** excluding the title, names of authors/co-authors, affiliations and disclosure.

ABBREVIATONS- Use standard abbreviation.

FONT- Times New Roman FONT SIZE- 12

Background: The use of *Vernonia amygdalina* and drugs for the treatment of various ailments is a common practice amongst patients

Objective: To evaluate the effects of Vernonia amygdalina water extract on the pharmacokinetics of metformin.

Method: The study involved

Results: Metformin administered alone (group 1) achieved C_{max} of 95.36 ng/mL at 7 hr Conclusion: Vernonia amygdalina water extract does not significantly affect the pharmacokinetics of metformin in healthy humans.
