CALL FOR INTRA-AFRICA ACADEMIC MOBILITY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

Applicants are invited ONLY from African countries nationalities for scholarships in the fields of **Materials Science, Solar Energy Physics, Chemistry Specialization in Inorganic Chemistry, Materials Electrochemistry and Energy Technologies and Physical Chemistry** under **ESIMSAD project**. ESIMSAD scholarships are jointly administered by five Partner universities;(4) African partner Universities, and (1) EU-Technical University where selected students and staff will be able to engage in postgraduate studies, research, teaching or training. The 3rd ESIMSAD Call offers 8 PhD Credit-seeking, and 8 MSc (2 degree-seeking and 6 credit-seeking).

SCHOLARSHIPS

The ESIMSAD scholarship includes a return air ticket and visa costs, participation costs, Insurance (health, accident, travel), settling-in allowance, monthly subsistence allowance and a contribution towards the research costs associated with student mobility of 10 months or longer. The ESIMSAD consortium is committed to offering 50% of its scholarships to women and candidates from disadvantaged or marginalized groups.

**Previous and current recipients of intra-ACP or Intra-Africa Academic mobility scholarships are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.*
