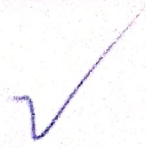

The total score for the programme is 84.2%. It scored 25.0(89.3%) in academic matters, 31.0(88.6%) in staffing, 13.0(81.3%) in physical facilities and 13.4(74.4%) in library. The programme scored 2.0(66.7%) in funding, 3.0(100%) in research and collaboration and 1.0(50.0%) in tracer and employers' rating. Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library, the panel recommended FULL accreditation status for the programme.

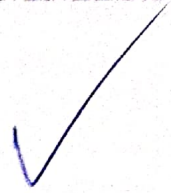
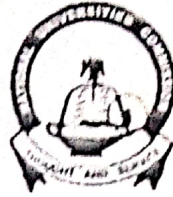

The programme scored 1.0(33.3%) in funding, 3.0(100%) in research and collaboration and 2.0(100%) in tracer and employers' rating. Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in **academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library**, the panel recommended **FULL** accreditation status for the programme.

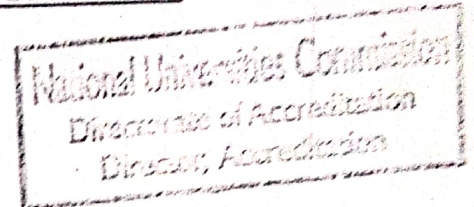

3. There is no evidence of minutes of meetings of the internal quality assurance unit.	3. The University should ensure that minutes of meetings of the internal quality assurance unit are adequately documented.
4. 40.8% of the academic staff and 80% of the non-teaching staff have not benefitted from Staff Development Programme.	4. The University is encouraged to ensure that all academic staff and non-teaching staff benefit from Staff Development Programme.
5. Professorial offices are inadequate in space.	5. Standard (spacious) professorial offices should be provided for the programme.

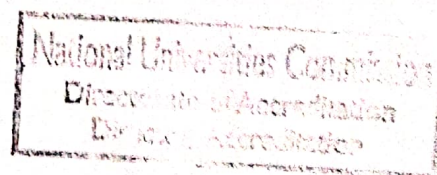

1. Marking schemes are not well developed as bloc allocation of marks was observed.	1. Marking schemes should be well developed with specific mark allocation to questions.
2. Classrooms for 100level and 200level students are inadequate in space.	2. Standard and spacious classrooms should be provided for 100level and 200level students.
3. Academic staff offices are not well furnished with standard furniture, air conditioners and refrigerators.	3. Standard and well furnished offices should be provided for the academic staff of the programme.

The total score for the programme is 90.4%. It scored 34.0(91.8%) in academic matters, 35.0(100%) in staffing, 20.0(74.0%) in physical facilities and 17.0(94.4%) in library. The programme scored 2.0(66.7%) in funding, 3.0(100%) in research and collaborations and 2.0(100%) in tracer and employers' rating. Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in **academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library**, the panel recommended **FULL** accreditation status for the programme.

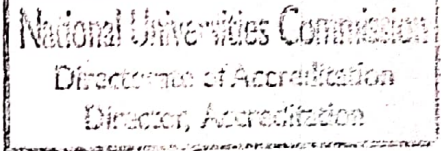

4. Fire extinguishers and sand buckets are inadequate in number.	4. The University should ensure that more fire extinguishers and other firefighting equipment/devices are installed at strategic locations for the programme.
5. Physical library books and journals are inadequate in number and currency.	5. More current books and journals should be procured for the programme.
6. Funding is inadequate for the programme.	6. The programme should be adequately funded.

The total score for the programme is 86.1%. It scored 34.3(92.8%) in academic matters, 33.0(94.3%) in staffing, 20.0(74.1%) in physical facilities and 14.3(79.7%) in library. The programme scored 2.0(66.7%) in funding, 2.3(77.7%) in research and collaborations and 1.7(83.5%) in tracer and employers' rating. Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in **academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library**, the panel recommended **FULL** accreditation status for the programme.

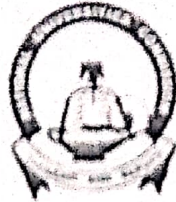

4. Academic staff offices are inadequate in space and number.	4. Adequate number of standard offices for academic staff should be provided for the programme.

The total score for the programme is 81.6%. It scored 28.0(87.5%) in academic matters, 28.0(80.0%) in staffing, 23.0(82.1%) in physical facilities and 14.0(77.7%) in library. The programme scored 2.0(66.7%) in funding, 1.0(33.3%) in research and collaborations and 2.0(100%) in tracer and employers' rating. Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in **academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library**, the panel recommended **FULL** accreditation status for the programme.

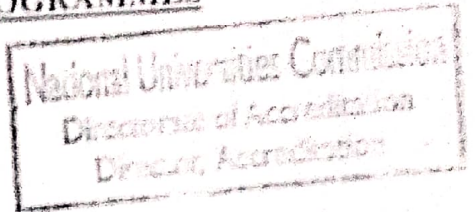
