The programme scored 2.0(66.7%) in funding, 3.0(100%) in research and collaboration and 1.0(50.0%) in tracer and employers' rating. Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library, the panel recommended FULL accreditation status for the programme.

Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library, the panel recommended FULL accreditation status for the programme.



Based on the total score and the fact that the programme scored up to 70% in academic matters, staffing, physical facilities and library, the panel recommended FULL accreditation status for the programme.
