

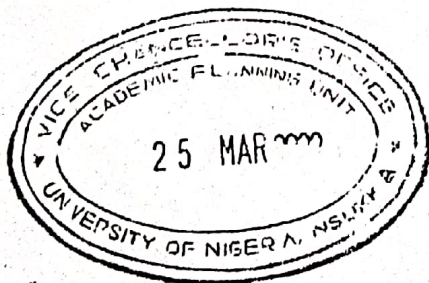
1. Biomedical Engineering (B.Eng.)

3. B.A. Tourism Studies

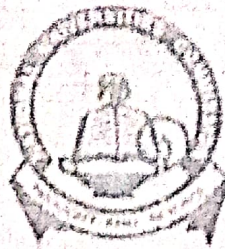
The University is requested to note that three (3) panels consisting of nine (9) members will be assessing the programmes' resources (details attached). The arrival date is 12th September, 2021.

I am directed to inform the Vice-Chancellor that the Executive Secretary has considered and approved the establishment of the full-time mode of the following undergraduate programmes, to be run in the Main Campus of the University with effect from 2023/2024 academic session:


1. B.Sc. Criminology and Security Studies
2. B.Sc. Marine Science

I am to add that the approval *does not* cover the part-time mode of delivery of the programmes.

The University is advised to improve on the deficiencies indicated against the under-listed programmes:

1. B.Sc. Marine Science: The University should change the nomenclature of the programme to Fisheries and Aquaculture and domicile it in the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences. The university should also provide more current library holdings for books and journals (both local and foreign) for the programme.
2. B.Sc. Criminology and Security Studies: The University should improve on the local content library resources for the programme. The University should properly furnish academic offices and the laboratory should be well-stocked with updated materials.

The programmes shall bear only the approved title and nomenclature and any change will require approval of the Commission. The University is enjoined to provide adequate human and material resources for the development and growth of the approved programmes.
