Open gateways in the form of scholarship and non-scholarship programme to assist Nigerian youths gain access to ordinary craft level and advanced craft level Education for gainful employment. The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed by the University Management and ZEANI Management on 22<sup>nd</sup>, February 2024. ZEANI and UNN Nsukka Open 2024 Admissions for Technical Skills Programme.

#### **Programme Overview**

ZEANI-UNN's CDSE programme is designed to provide both scholarship and non-scholarship opportunities in Technical Vocational Education and Training (TVET). The programme aims to reach youth in local communities, offering education and training in various trades at ordinary and advanced craft levels. It is regulated by the National Board for Technical Education (NBTE), approved and supported by the Enugu State Ministry of Education.

- Individuals seeking to overcome poverty through formal apprenticeship education.
- Candidates interested in technical and vocational-oriented schooling.
- Persons with informal technical knowledge or native skills needing certification.
- Those aiming to progress from craftsmanship to engineering or technical education roles.
- Individuals without formal education seeking professional technical training.
- Workers looking to qualify for ordinary or advanced craft levels.
- Graduates, artisans, and tradespersons wanting to enhance their technical skills.
- JAMB candidates pursuing indirect or direct entry into higher education institutions.

**Programme Regulation and Support:** It is regulated by the National Board for Technical Education (NBTE), approved and supported by Enugu State Ministry of Education. This programme is led by Professor J.A Okonze, Director of the Centre for Technical, Vocational Education, Training and Research (CETVETAR), and Professor E.O Anaele, Dean of the Faculty of Vocational Technical Education (VTE), the programme also offers a unique opportunity for aspiring students and professionals.
